In New Jersey, all insurance policies come with a "verbal or limitation on lawsuit" option. This prevents people from suing their insurance companies unless they meet certain requirements, such as:

- Death
- Dismemberment
- Loss of a fetus
- Significant disfigurement or significant scarring (as judged by an observer, not the injured)
- Displaced fracture (simple fractures do not meet the threshold requirement unless they cause a permanent injury after healing)
- Permanent injury, within a reasonable degree of medical probability

Selecting the "no threshold" option allows you to sue your insurance company for the damage done to you by the negligent party.
